About the Health Care Center (revised on May 17, 2010)

The Health Care Center supports the physical and mental health of all the members of Saga University by providing primary health care, prevention-focused services, and medical information to develop health knowledge and practical health-care skills. The Center is staffed by experienced doctors and nurses, and is located on both the Honjo Campus and the Nabeshima Campus.

Fees

All registered students are eligible to get free on-campus services, such as regular medical examination, first-aid treatment, and health consultation. However, you are charged to see a doctor at the University Hospital or other medical clinics outside campus. You need to show an insurance card when you use the services.

Medical Examinations

Regular medical examinations are provided for all students, and are carried out annually in April or May. International Students who are enrolled for the second semester can take the medical examinations in October. Check our website or notice board for further information.

Certificate of Health

We can issue a certificate of health to all students who have taken the annual medical examination at the Center. The application form should be submitted to get a certificate of health.

Health Consultation

Free individual consultations are available for students wanting to consult a doctor about mental or physical problems. You should call first to make an appointment. If you are reluctant for some reasons to visit the center, you can have a phone consultation upon request. We can also provide medical information and medical referral to all international students and their families.

* Consultations between counselor and student are confidential.

First-aid treatment

When you have a cold or stomachache, or when you are injured, you can have a proper treatment and medicine at the Center.

Equipment at the Center:

You may take a rest in bed at the Center if you feel ill. Additionally we offer the medical instruments, such as weight scales, a blood pressure manometer in order that students can check and take care of their own health.

Relaxation Room on Honjo Campus

Relaxation is an important part of keeping good health. We offer a relaxation room for students to relieve their stress.
